NAPLAN

The NAPLAN Testing will be occurring in Term 1 for students in years 3 and 5. The testing window is open from 12th – 24th March. Our aim is to have them done in the first few days. These tests provide useful data for individual achievement in comparison with national results and are a means of identifying particular needs at each year level. They are, however, one mode of assessment in the overall learning program and St Joseph's School uses a variety of assessment strategies. Any parents of Yr. 3 and 5 students are welcome to speak to Mrs. Tenney should you have any questions or concerns regarding NAPLAN in 2025

SCHOOL FEES STATEMENTS

SCHOOL CARDS

Just a reminder that School Card applications are now open and we strongly encourage families to check the eligibility thresholds, in the link below.

If you're family are eligible you will receive financial assistance with a reduction in school fees.

To qualify for a School Card, your family's gross income must be below a certain limit, which depends on how many dependent children you have.

The income limits for applications lodged in 2025 are based on your family's gross income 2023-2024
